Task: Begin to study people and places

Train your eye to really see the world and people around you. Take your People and Places sketchbook out and about with you. Also, bring an HB or 2B pencil. Here are some ideas for what to sketch:

1. Sketch people waiting at traffic lights or for public transport. Keep the sketches loose and quick. Try and capture movement and expression.
2. Sketch a building or street corner that appeals to you. Again, keep the sketch loose and fast.
3. Take a picture of a building or place with your phone and use the picture as a reference. Use continuous line drawing to recreate the building or place in line.
4. You can use the same continuous line technique, drawing the view outside your window.
5. Sketch while sitting at a cafe. Sketch everything you see using continuous line drawing techniques. You might like to introduce simple texture into your drawing.
