Write your character into a scene

Write a 200-300 word scene from the point of view of one of your favourite character from this module.

This piece can be in the first or third person. It might be sweet, funny, heartwarming, endearing ... the tone is up to you!

The scene might be anything: a birthday, a mission, a journey, an experience, a feeling. You might give your character a goal and a problem: something to work towards. You might use one of your ideas from Module One as inspiration.

Some tips:

- Keep your character active and motivated
- Give your character agency: make sure they are directing action and making decisions
- Show us how your character feels through body language and tone of voice
- Keep dialogue concise and relevant
- Remember to put yourself in the character's shoes and experience the scene from their point of view.

Have fun with this! Let your words flow and your character emerge.
