### Task: Point of view

Point of view is the perspective from which we tell the story. When you are writing your story, step into the character's experience and tell their story from their point of view. This can be in first or third person. The important thing is to always try and remember what the character sees, feels, hears, experiences etc.

Write a paragraph in third or first person, from the point of view in each of the characters brainstormed in the earlier task. Really see the world from their perspective. For example, if your character is small, the world around them might seem big.

If your character talks during your piece, try and manifest the character's voice as much as possible. It might help to listen to real-life children speaking, if you are writing from the perspective of a child.
