Task: Create a bird's eye view

Using different perspectives in your illustrations helps make your picture book vibrant and unique.

Create a frame. Use a simple object as your model and add a light source as well as a horizon line.

Drawing your object from a bird's eye view and throwing a dramatic longer shadow puts a simple object into a different and interesting perspective. Changing the angle creates drama.

You might like to create a few frames and try different angles and shadow lengths.
