Illustration assignment: Create a storyboard & a dummy book

Part A

Make a storyboard for your 32-page picture book. You might like to start with thumbnails to get the best result possible.

Start by breaking up your text into 32 pages so that it is cohesive and flows well. What do you want to say and show on each page? How will you keep the reader entertained? Keep it simple and clear. Consider using vignettes and other layouts discussed in the video.

Which pages are going to be full bleeds, which will be half-page spreads? Which scenes are shown in vignettes? Keep your storyboard as lively and as buoyant as you can.
